General Requirements


- 1. No person shall make any connection to the sewer system unless a valid building sewer connection permit is issued by the Town. Prior to issuance of any connection permit, the permit and inspection fee of \$75.00 must be paid.
- 2. Application for a building sewer connection permit must be made by the owner of the building which is to be connected with the public sewer, on the attached application form. A separate permit is required for each building to be connected.
- 3. Connection to the public sewer is mandatory for new buildings and new building additions and for buildings with failing septic systems or where partial septic repairs were allowed by the Sanitarian, pending sewer installation.
- 4. The Town's Sewer Ordinance, adopted March 9, 1982 and subsequent regulations and details will apply to the workmanship and materials associated with the connection and use of the sewers.
- 5. Building sewer connection permits will only be issued to:

A licensed contractor holding a valid State of Connecticut license to perform the unsupervised installation of sewer mains, services and appurtenances: or

A person owning and residing in a single-family house and installing his/her building sewer pipe within the confines of his/her property.


- 6. The owner/contractor must consult with the Public Works Department prior to commencing any work on the building sewer connection to review scheduling, as-built location of the existing lateral stub to the property and the Town's sewer ordinance requirements.
- 7. The owner/contractor shall notify the Connecticut "Call Before You Dig" clearinghouse at (800) 922-4455 in accordance with the requirements of Section 16-345-1 through 16-345-7, inclusive of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, Department of Public Utility Control and shall provide the Town with the CBYD location request number.


- 8. The Owner/Contractor will be required to post with the Town, a Certificate for Public Liability Insurance (\$100,000 Ea. Person, \$1,000,000 Ea. Accident, a \$50,000 Property Damage), a Performance and Guaranty Bond (\$5,000), and a copy of their current Contractor's License Certificate, where applicable.
- 9. No trench containing a sewer pipe or other appurtenance can be backfilled until the Town Inspector or his authorized agent has completed an inspection and found the work to conform to the requirements of the Town in all respects and to be satisfactory as to the quality of workmanship and materials. The Contractor/Owner must notify the Town Inspector (342-6733) twenty-four (24) hours before starting any work authorized under the permit, and for subsequent inspections.
- 10. Any person who is in violation of any sections of the Town's Sewer Ordinance and other applicable regulations, or fails to give adequate notice to the Town Inspector for an inspection of the work, may be halted and/or required to uncover the work for inspection and approval.
- 11. Permits may be revoked and annulled by the Town for any violation of the Town's Sewer Ordinance, or suspended for a reasonable time, to permit the Town to make an investigation to determine if there has been a violation of the regulations.
- 12. Permits shall be valid for a period of three hundred sixty-five (365) days, except in the event the property changes ownership before the work is completed or if another Contractor is chosen to perform or complete the work, the original permit becomes void and a new permit shall be obtained by the new parties in interest.
- 13. All connections requiring easements and/or other agreements must have such easements and/or agreements approved executed and recorded on the Land Record prior to issuance of a permit for connection to the sanitary sewer.
- 14. All excavations for building sewer installation shall be adequately guarded with barricades and lights so as to protect the public from hazards.
- 15. No roof downspouts, foundation drains, sump pumps or any sources of surface runoff or groundwater can be connected to the building sewer or public sewer.
- 16. Any change in direction of the building sewer exceeding a 45 degree angle must have a cleanout.
- 17. All septic tanks must be abandoned by being pumped out, removed or crushed and filled. The Town Inspector must be contacted to confirm that the septic tank has been properly abandoned.
- 18. Any relocation/replacement of sewer piping inside the building, requires a plumbing permit and inspection from the Building Official (342-6727).
