require detailed plans and specifications and other engineering data to be submitted with the application when he shall deem such to be necessary. The permit shall be obtained at least 72 hours prior to commencement of excavation activities.

Sec. 17-67. Fees.

Contractors applying for a permit issued pursuant to this division shall pay a fee to the town in the amounts computed by measuring the surface area of such excavation as follows:

- (1) \$10.00 for the first 500 square feet of excavation or fraction thereof; and
- (2) \$10.00 for each additional 500 square feet of excavation or fraction thereof, as indicated below:

Sec. 17-68. Insurance and bond.

- (a) No permit for an excavation in any town street or highway in the town shall be granted until the contractor shall file with the first selectman proof of insurance as follows:
 - (1) Automobile. \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit for bodily injury and/or property damage.
 - (2) Comprehensive general liability (including products and completed operations). \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit for bodily injury and/or property damage.
 - (3) Worker's compensation. Limit per state statute, \$100,000.00 employer's liability.
 - (4) Umbrella. \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence.
- (b) Proof of a performance bond in the minimum amount of \$5,000.00 and in greater amounts as indicated below. Such performance bond will be an amount relative to the area to be excavated as determined by the director of public works, all predicated on the contractor restoring the street or highway to a condition as approved by the director of public works.
